

2021 Chinese Government Scholarship-WMO Program

CSC-WMO Scholarship

WMO Program is the scholarship established by the Chinese Ministry of Education (MOE) for the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) to sponsor international students to study and conduct research in meteorology in China.



Program Details

1. **Supporting Category** This program supports undergraduate students, master students, and doctoral students.

2. Duration

(1) It supports undergraduates for no more than 5 academic years (including both preparatory study and major study).

(2) It supports master students for no more than 2 academic years, or doctoral students for no more than 4 academic years.

3. Instruction Language

(1) Undergraduate scholarship recipients must register for Chinese-taught credit courses.

(2) Master and doctoral students must register for English-taught credit courses.

4. Majors at Nanjing University of Information Science & Technology (NUIST)

(1) Undergraduate Programs: Atmospheric Science (weather forecasting oriented), Applied Meteorology (agriculture meteorology oriented).

(2) Master Programs: Meteorology (weather forecasting, climate oriented), Applied Meteorology (agriculture meteorology, ecology oriented)

Scholarship Coverage Full scholarship.

Where to apply your should apply to NUIST and WMO Secretariat.

When to apply you need to apply before March 31, 2021.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China and be in good health.

2. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:

- be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for the undergraduate programs;
 - be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master's programs.
 - be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs.
3. Applicants must have outstanding academic records (CGPA 3.0 or above out of 4)
 4. Applicants for undergraduate programs must provide a valid Chinese proficiency test certificate (HSK Level 3 or above).

Application Procedures

Step 1 –Complete the online application procedure in **CGS Information**

System (Visit <http://www.campuschina.org> and click “Scholarship Application for Students” to log in) , submit online the completed **Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship** and print a hard copy (sign and date). “Program Category” and “Agency Number” is mandatory for the online application in CGS Information System. Please choose “**Program Category A**” and the Agency Number **00002**.

Step 2–Get nomination from the Permanent Representative of the country with WMO.

Step 3 –Apply to NUIST for the Pre-admission Letter by doing the NUIST online application (visit <http://nuist.17gz.org/member/login.do>). Please choose "**Chinese Government Scholarship**" and submit application documents including WMO Fellowship Nomination Form (FNF).

Step 4 –Submit WMO FNF, copy of CSC online application form, and university pre-admission letter to WMO Secretariat before the deadline.**NOTE:** Only applications of recommended candidates from the WMO Secretariat will be considered.

Application Documents

1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (in English or Chinese);
2. The Notarized highest diploma; Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations. Prospective diploma recipients must submit an official document issued by their current school to prove their current student status or expected graduation date.
3. Academic transcripts; Undergraduate applicants must submit transcripts of their high school graduation examinations. Master applicants must submit their bachelor's transcripts. Doctoral applicants must submit their master's transcripts. Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
4. A Study Plan or Research Proposal (in Chinese or English); This should be a minimum of 200 words for undergraduate applicants, and 800 words for master and doctoral applicants.
5. Two Recommendation Letters (in Chinese or English); Master and doctoral applicants must submit two recommendation letters signed by a professor or an associate professor. Professors' signature, contact phone number, and email address must be put on the letter.

6. Doctoral applicants must submit an acceptance letter signed by a doctoral supervisor from NUIST. The information of doctoral supervisors is available on <https://gjy.nuist.edu.cn/english/PhwDPrograms/list.htm>, and the acceptance form can be downloaded from the following website: <https://gjy.nuist.edu.cn/english/DownloadforAdmission/list.htm>.
 7. Valid Documents of Your Legal Guardians in China (only required for applicants under the age of 18);
 8. Foreigner Physical Examination Form; It must be written in English, and can be downloaded from the following website: <https://gjy.nuist.edu.cn/english/DownloadforAdmission/list.htm>;
- The physical examinations must cover all of the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete forms or forms without the signature of the attending physician, or the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicant are considered invalid. Please carefully plan your physical examination schedule as the result is valid for only 6 months.
9. WMO Fellowship Nomination Form (FNF);
 10. Pre-admission Letter from NUIST;
 11. Passport photo page;
 12. Language proficiency certificate; The copy of valid HSK Certificate (Level 3 or above) for undergraduate programs application. The copy of valid TOEFL (80 or above) or IELTS (6.0 or above) Certificate for master and doctoral programs application (only for applicants from non-English speaking countries).
 13. Non-criminal record report; The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months before the submission date of the application.
 14. Other supporting materials (if available, such as published papers, job certificates, certificates of awards and training, etc.).

Reminder: All uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic, and valid. Applicants are recommended to use the professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.

Placement & Scholarship Confirmation

1. Application documents of recommended candidates from WMO will be considered by CSC for eligibility and qualification. Ineligible or incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Qualified applications will be sent to NUIST for placement. Based on various factors, such as the different scholarship funding requirements of every country, the host university's teaching capacity, study

length, and applicants' criteria, CSC reserves the right to make necessary adjustments/changes to the field of study, supporting categories, and duration of scholarship.

3. Scholarship recipients will get Chinese government scholarships to study in China with approval by CSC. Each scholarship recipient will be granted no more than one scholarship.

4. CSC sends the List of Scholarship Recipients, Letter of Admission, and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) to WMO Secretariat before June 15th. Then WMO Secretariat will send these documents to the scholarship recipients. 5. Scholarship recipients shall not be allowed to change their host university, the field of study, or duration of study stipulated on the **Admission Letter** after they came to China. 6. Scholarships will not be reserved if the scholarship recipient cannot register before the registration deadline.
